



TATTOO BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Before confirming your booking, please take a moment to read the following information carefully.

These terms help ensure a clear and respectful collaboration and allow the creative process to unfold in the best possible way.

1. WHEN YOUR BOOKING BECOMES OFFICIAL

Your appointment becomes officially confirmed only once the deposit has been received.

Until that moment, the date remains available to other clients.

2. DEPOSIT

The deposit reserves your dates and the time dedicated exclusively to your project.

For this reason, the deposit is not refundable under any circumstances.

3. IF YOU CANCEL OR CHANGE YOUR DATES

If you cancel your tattoo project or move your appointment to another date, the deposit will be lost,

as the reserved time was held exclusively for you.

4. IF I NEED TO RESCHEDULE

In the rare case that I have an unforeseen circumstance that prevents the session from taking place,

the appointment will be moved to a new available date.

This is the only case in which the deposit remains valid for a new date.

Please note that this will not include reimbursement for flights, accommodation, or other travel-related expenses.

5. TRAVEL RECOMMENDATION

Based on experience, I recommend booking flights and accommodation with flexible options so any unexpected situation can be managed more easily.

6. SKIN CONDITION

It is important to arrive at the session with your skin in the best possible condition.

Please avoid direct sun exposure for at least two months before the appointment and arrive with your skin as light as possible.

If the skin is sunburned, heavily tanned, or otherwise not suitable for tattooing, I may decide to postpone the session for safety and quality reasons.

In this case, the deposit will not be refunded, as the date has been reserved exclusively for you.

ACCEPTANCE

By paying the deposit and securing your dates, you automatically confirm that you have read and accepted all the terms listed above.
